# PARISH CHURCH WEBCAM

The camera has been causing trouble lately, having a mind of its own so to speak! The camera runs 24 hours a day and is costly. Webcams were installed in most churches during Covid as a way of reaching out to those who were not allowed to attend Mass. Everyone is allowed to attend Mass now so going forward the use of the camera will be reduced with a view of eventually removing it.

## THE SUNDAY OBLIGATION TO ATTEND MASS IN PERSON:

At Easter 2023 the Bishops restored the obligation to attend Mass for all Catholics. This means that viewing Mass online no longer fulfils your Sunday obligation. Attendance at weekday Mass instead of Sunday does not fulfil the obligation either. *The sick and infirm have an exemption from the obligation*. During Holy Mass we are nourished by the Body of Christ, this cannot be done online! Prayerful preparation and sacramental confession are most important for the reception of the Eucharist.

# CONFIRMATION AND FIRST HOLY COMMUNION REGISTRATION:

The Enrolment ceremony for the Sacrament of Confirmation and First Holy Communion Will take place in October.
