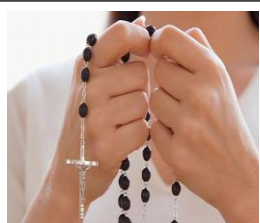
CONFIRMATION AND FIRST HOLY COMMUNION REGISTRATION:
