The Church in its pilgrim members, from the very earliest days of the Christian religion, has always honoured with great respect the memory of the dead, and because it is a holy and a wholesome thought to pray for our loved one's departed. After all remembering them in prayer is the only gift we can give them now. We do that by offering up Mass on the 1<sup>st</sup> Friday of every month. By submitting your departed loved one's names on a list, they are included and remembered in a special way at that Mass. List of the Dead Envelopes are available in the Churches. Please return them as soon as possible to be included in these Masses.

### Meals on Wheels Appeal for new volunteer drivers.

We are delighted to report that the number of people availing of our service has grown in the past year and we now deliver to almost 30 homes every week.

We urgently need new volunteer drivers to help us to deliver to people in Oldcastle, Moylagh and Ballinacree communities. We operate a rota system which means that you will only be required to deliver one week in every six weeks. We are making an appeal to anyone who can spare one hour, on Tuesdays and Thursdays, once every six weeks, to deliver a dinner to elderly and vulnerable people in our community.

We raised the magnificent amount of **€12,136** in the **Duck Derby Fundraiser** this year. €5,000 was presented to Meath River Rescue, and €5,000 was presented to National Council for the Blind. The remaining funds are being allocated to various local charites. A huge thank you, once again, to everyone that contributed to this great outcome, for very deserving causes Moylagh GAA Club invites you to support our 24-hour Cycleton event over the weekend of the 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> October in Teddies. The event commences at 7pm on the 28th. All funds raised will support the development of our new community walking track.
