The Bishop will bless everyone present with the Relic of St Oliver This year marks the 49th Anniversary of his Canonisation in Rome by Pope Paul VI in 1975

Saint Oliver Plunkett (born on the 1st November 1625 at Loughcrew, Oldcastle, County Meath - died on the 1st July 1681 at Tyburn, London) he was the Roman Catholic Archbishop of Armagh and Primate of All Ireland.

He maintained his duties in Ireland in the face of English persecution and was eventually arrested and tried for treason in London. He was hanged, drawn and quartered at Tyburn on 1 July 1681, and became the last Roman Catholic martyr to die in England. Oliver Plunkett was beatified in 1920 and canonised in 1975, the first new Irish Saint for almost seven hundred years.

The key message of both letter and video asserts that every person possesses inherent, infinite dignity that remains intact regardless of their circumstances. In this context, bishops strongly oppose the Oireachtas Committee's proposal to Government to legislate for assisted suicide, and call on support for healthcare workers who uphold the sanctity of life.
