Sunday 12th October: Healing Mass & Golden Jubilee of Canonisation of Saint Oliver, Armagh Cathedral

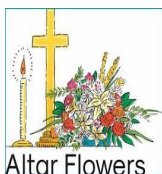
Saturday 1st November: 400th Anniversary of the birth of Saint Oliver, Mass in Oldcastle 7pm
