ADVENT WEEK 4

As this final Sunday of Advent, we light the candle of LOVE.

Theme: "Love Draws Near"

We stand with Mary and Joseph, waiting for Christ to be born among us. God's love draws close to our parish, our homes, and our hearts.



In these last days before Christmas, I invite you to draw close to the Holy Family in your own home. This could be:

Prayer at the Crib or Image:

If there's a crib, gather there; if not, use a cross, candle, or holy picture. Say: "Jesus, Mary and Joseph, bless our home. Stay with us and help us to love one another"

Name and Pray for Loved Ones:

Write a short list of people you want to place near the crib this Christmas (family, friends, someone away from home, someone struggling) and pray one Our Father for them.

One Concrete Act of Love:

Each person chooses one deliberate act of love this week: visiting or phoning someone lonely, helping a neighbour or making peace in the family.



In both the First Reading and the Gospel this weekend we hear Jesus called "Emmanuel" - a name that means "God-is-with-us!" We pray for an increase in vocations to the diocesan priesthood, and that the future priests of our diocese will be modern-day Emmanuels - the loving. healing, forgiving, and merciful presence of God in the Church and in the world.
